

## Letter of Invitation for Bids

Dushanbe, Republic of Tajikistan

**Re:** CASP+/GCF/CEP/G/NCB-2026/03

1. The Republic of Tajikistan has received financing from the International Fund for Agricultural Development (IFAD) towards the cost of Community-based Agriculture Support Project “plus” (CASP+) and intends to apply part of the financing for the purchase of these goods. The use of any IFAD financing shall be subject to IFAD’s approval, pursuant to the terms and conditions of the financing agreement, as well as IFAD’s rules, policies and procedures. IFAD and its officials, agents and employees shall be held harmless from and against all suits, proceedings, claims, demands, losses and liability of any kind or nature brought by any party in connection with Community-based Agriculture Support Project “plus” (CASP+).
2. The Community-based Agriculture Support Project “plus” (CASP+) includes selected districts of Sughd, Khatlon and DRS, which have high poverty levels, yet potential for agriculture development.
3. This IFB follows the general procurement notice that appeared on the the United Nations Development Business (UNDB) website on 3 November 2023, and the project website (rural.tj) on 3 November 2023.
4. The Purchaser now invites sealed bids from eligible entities (“bidders”) for the provision of Mobile Offices for Environment Protection Departments and Joint Forest Management (JFM) Groups. More details on these goods and related services are provided in the schedule of requirements in this bidding document.
5. This IFB is open to all eligible bidders who wish to respond. Subject to the restrictions noted in the bidding document, eligible entities may associate with other bidders to enhance their capacity to successfully deliver the goods and related services.
6. Bidding will be conducted using the national competitive bidding (NCB) method, the evaluation procedure for which is described in this bidding document, in accordance with the IFAD Procurement Handbook which is provided at [www.ifad.org/project-procurement](http://www.ifad.org/project-procurement). The NCB process, as described, will include a review and verification of qualifications and past performance, including a reference check, prior to the contract award.
7. Please note that a pre-bid conference will not be held as described in the bid data sheet BDS, Section II of the bidding document.
8. Bids must be delivered to the address below and in the manner specified in the BDS ITB 23.2(b) no later than 17 June 2026, 15:00.
